Sacramento NCBW 2023 Memorial Scholarship Criteria and Instructions

DEADLINE: Application must be postmarked or emailed by May 15, 2023.

Scholarship criteria includes the following:

1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior, current full time community college or university student in good standing.
2. He/She must reside within a 50-mile radius of City of Sacramento.
3. Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 overall grade point average (GPA). Unofficial transcripts are accepted with the application. If awarded, scholar must provide the official high school or college transcript(s). **Transcripts must be mailed unopened or submitted electronically by the school administration.**
4. Applicant must submit:
 - An essay of no more than two pages one-sided, single spaced, 12pt Arial font.
 - Two letters of recommendation: One from a college mentor, faculty member, or high school teacher or counselor. And one from a community leader familiar with scholar's community and charitable activities.
5. Applicant must respond to essay prompts. See instructions at the bottom of this page.
6. Scholarship finalist may be required to participate in an in-person or virtual interview.
7. Selected candidates are **required to attend the June 10, 2023, virtual awards ceremony.**
